

Springfield College Health Center Requirements: Overview

REQUIREMENTS MUST BE COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED TO THE HEALTH CENTER NO LATER THAN July 15th FOR FALL ENTRY, December 15th FOR SPRING ENTRY, AND April 15th FOR SUMMER ENTRY.

These requirements are not related to the student health insurance

All fulltime and traditional undergraduate and graduate students, and all part time health science students, are required to complete health forms regardless of housing.

HEALTH FORMS: *(as required by Massachusetts law)*

- ❑ **Page one – Health history**
 - To be completed and signed by the student. Parents signature required if under the age of 18.

- ❑ **Page two – Physical examination and Tuberculosis Questionnaire**
 - Physical exam must be dated within one year prior to the first day of classes.
 - Admission physicals may be scheduled in the Health Center free of charge until the above deadline. **After the health form deadline a \$30 fee will be charged for physical examinations.**
 - If you answer YES to any of the TB screening questions you must download and submit the Tuberculosis Screening form with documentation of any necessary testing

- ❑ **Page three – Immunizations**
 - To be completed and signed by a health care provider.

Additional Information:

- **Partially completed health forms will not be accepted and will be returned to the student for completion**
- **Full clearance for registration and sports participation WILL NOT be granted until all health requirements have been completed and submitted to the Health Center.**
- HIPPA Disclosure – Please review the Privacy Practices and Confidentiality policy on the Health Center website as it pertains to the use of your health information.
- Please note that the Student Health Insurance is managed by the Business Office and is not a requirement for use of the Health Center. The Health Center does not directly bill a student's insurance but students are strongly encouraged to have a copy of their insurance and prescription cards when coming to college.
