

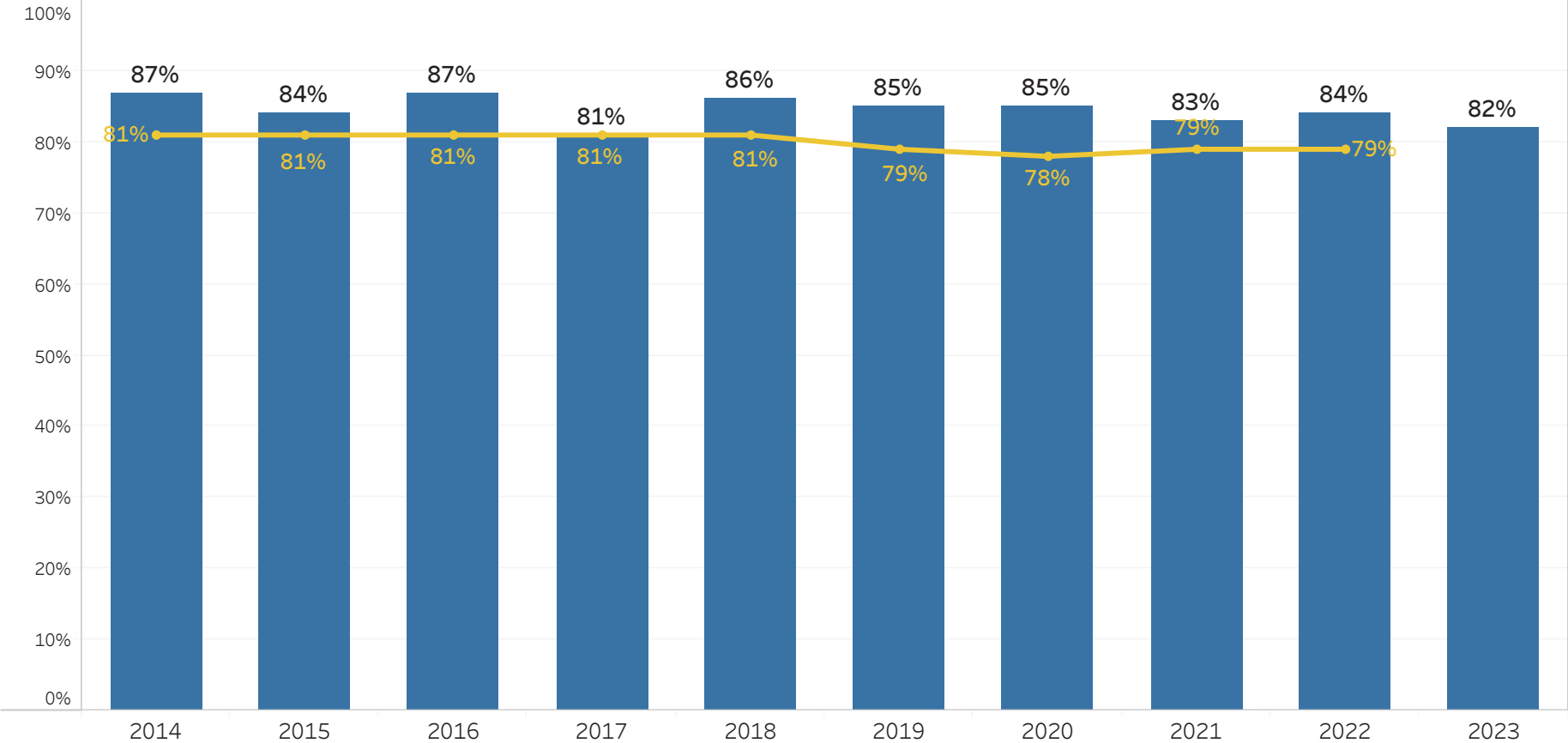

Retention Rates for First-time Full-time students (Fall Cohorts 2014-2023)

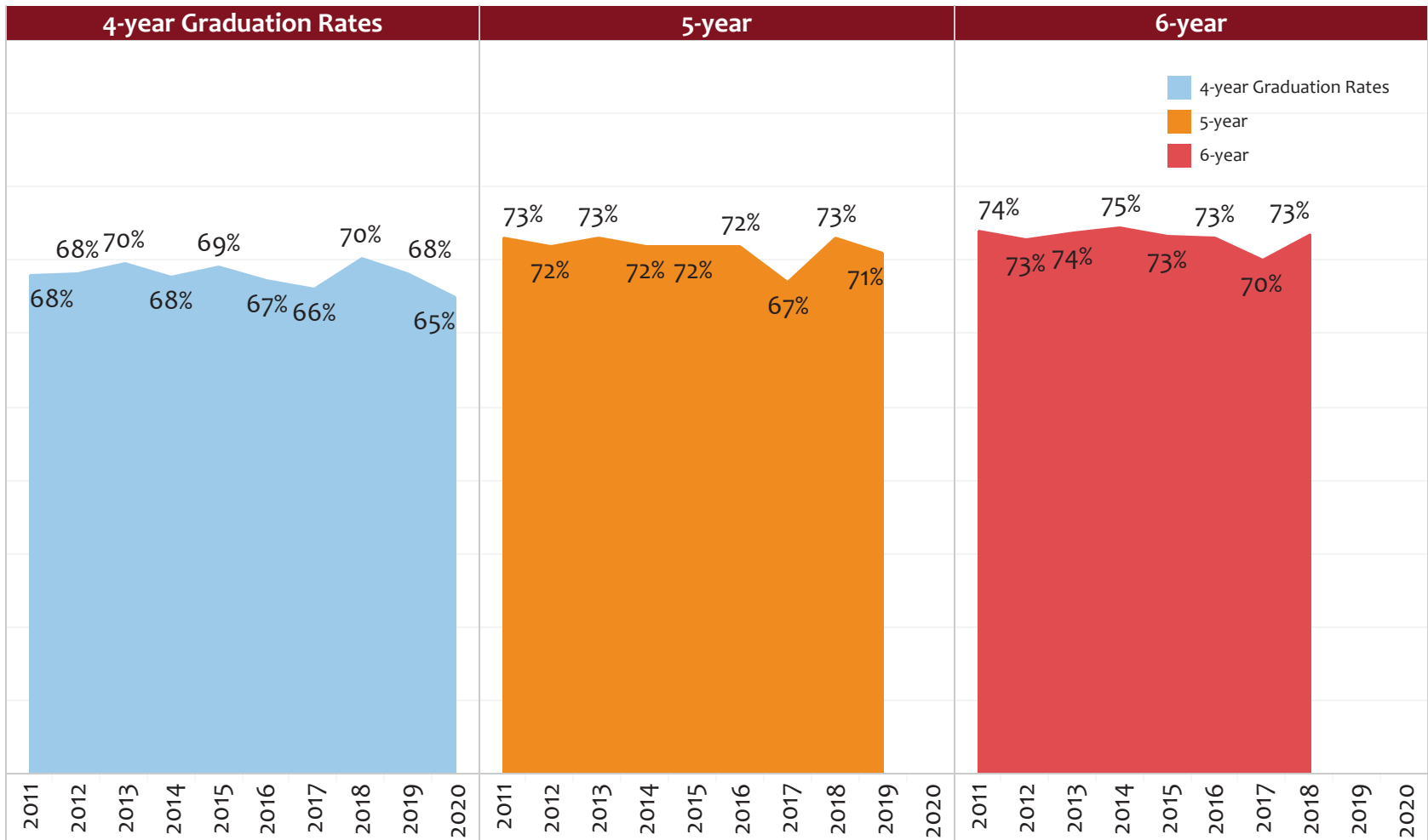


Springfield College - Blue Bars

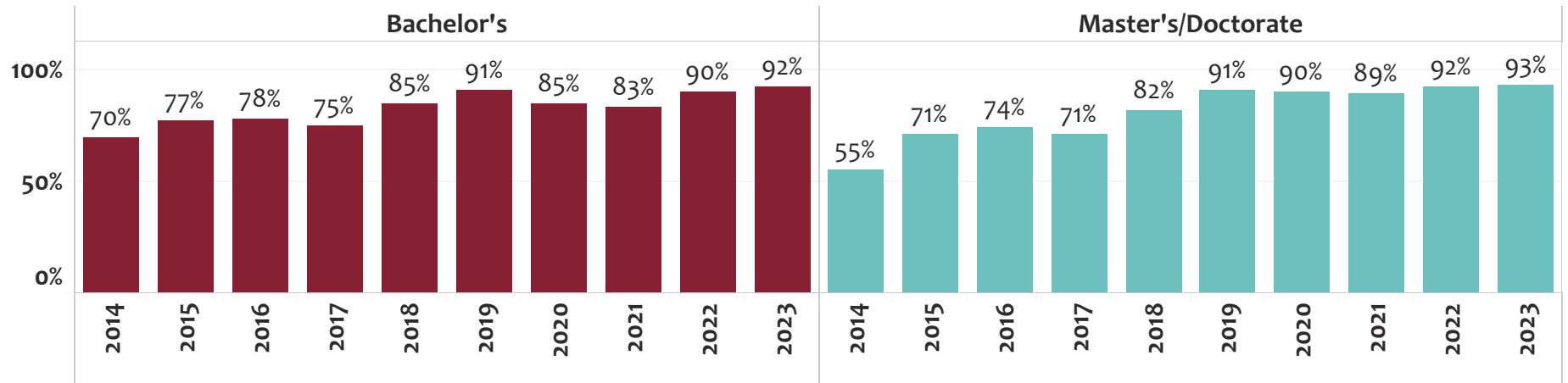

Technical Description of View: 4-, 5- and 6-year Graduation Rates for each Cohort Year, 2011-20. Different color for each time-to-degree.

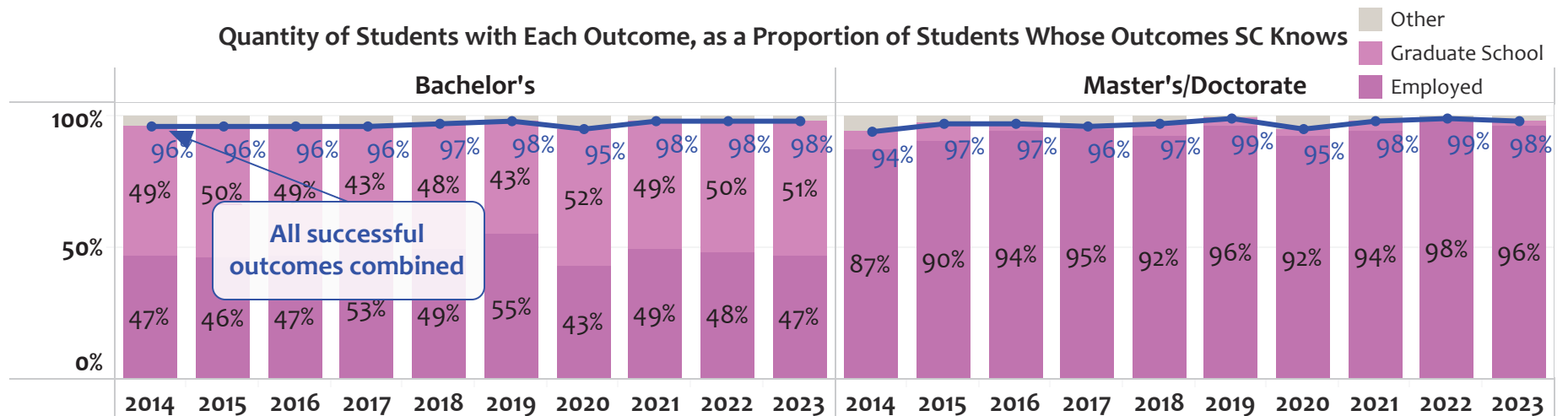

Technical description: Number of graduates with various career outcomes as of December of the academic year after their academic year of graduation, shown as a proportion of all graduates whose outcomes SC knows. The line graph shows the proportion of graduates with successful outcomes of any kind. Data is broken out by Academic Level and year, where for example, 2014 refers to graduations from Summer 2013 through Spring 2014.
