Writing Across the Curriculum (WAC)

Integrative Studies Major Area of Focus
INST majors must complete at least 24 credits of an approved area of focus in a particular discipline or a multi-disciplinary area. Depending on courses taken, students can also use those courses to fulfill an official minor. Courses used for the INST area of focus can NOT also be used to fulfill your Core or other major requirements.
Integrative Studies Major Advanced Coursework
INST majors must complete at least 24 credits of advanced coursework. These courses CAN not be used to fulfill your Core or other Major requirements. 200/300-level course
Integrative Studies Major Capstone Course
INST majors must complete the capstone course in their final semester. SPCO 401, Beyond Springfield College (1 credit)
Electives and College Requirements
In addition to the requirements previously listed, you must complete: • Enough elective credits to total at least 120 credits

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.000 or higher
 The residency requirement—45 credits taken at Springfield College (including 15 of your last 30)
