



International Graduate Student Housing Allowance

You may be eligible for an allowance towards the cost of your academic year housing, if you choose to live in graduate student housing at Springfield College. This allowance is offered to a select number of international graduate students who have been admitted to Springfield College, are degree-seeking full-time students, and have committed to attend Springfield College by submitting the enrollment deposit.

The allowance is valid for a period of up to 4 semesters (2 years, excluding Summer terms) while you are enrolled at Springfield College. It is only valid for Springfield College administered residences, it cannot be applied to independent housing.

Housing allowances are awarded on a first-come first-served basis, based on the date that you submit your \$300 deposit. Once you have decided to accept the offer of admission to Springfield College, we recommend you:

1. [submit your enrollment deposit](#) (If, at that time, all available housing allowances have been allocated, you may be placed on a waiting list in the event of cancellations, however we cannot guarantee that a housing allowance will be available for all students who would like one.)
2. contact the [Office of Residential Life](#) to reserve your on-campus housing as early as possible as graduate housing is limited and not guaranteed. The sooner you register for housing and submit your \$600 housing deposit the better your chances of securing housing. The housing deposit is applied towards the total cost of your housing, it is not a supplementary fee. This is not the same fee as your enrollment deposit.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- The international student housing allowance is valued at \$7,500 and is not intended to cover the entire cost of your housing on-campus. Springfield College [Graduate housing costs](#) vary depending on the housing unit and not all housing options may be available. If you choose, or are placed, in more expensive housing you will be responsible for paying the difference in cost. Springfield College will not incur these costs.
- Graduate student on-campus housing at Springfield College is limited and not guaranteed. On-campus housing for all students is made available on a first-come first-served basis. More information can be found at [Graduate On-Campus Housing](#).
- This award is ONLY available to confirmed Springfield College graduate students who choose to live in the Springfield College graduate housing (It cannot be used for independent housing not managed by Springfield College).
