\*This is a senior dance research project. This choreographic research explores different aspects of femininity and womanhood that feel empowering to me. While the choreography was vastly created through the lens of my individual experiences, an extremely important aspect of this work is the sense of community that is shared by all people who experience being perceived as a "woman" in society. This community is all encompassing, including cis women, trans women, trans men, non-binary people, queer women, and every person who has experienced aspects of womanhood. There is a sacred-like bond that is formed through shared experiences that impact and shape our view of the world. When we can feel and understand that connection, and grow together within it, we can become incredibly strong, resilient, and beautiful people who empower each other to feel and be our best selves all of the time. As part of this research, all of the dancers share parts of their own story, experiences with womanhood, and how they connect to women around them.
