Academic Attire

At today's commencement, faculty and graduates will be attired in academic regalia gowns, hoods, and mortarboards.

The history of this distinctive costuming goes back to the medieval universities of Europe where gowns were worn every day, providing both identification of the academic discipline and added warmth in poorly heated buildings.

The formal attire for campuses in the United States was established in 1895 with the adoption of the Academic Costume Code. It enables one to identify the wearer's degree and course of study and, in many cases, the college or university that awarded the degree.

Gowns for recipients of bachelor's and master's degrees are made of black cotton without trimming. Doctoral gowns are faced down the front and back in velvet and have three bars of the same material across the sleeves. The bachelor's gown has open sleeves; the master's sleeves are longer and closed with arm slits at the elbow; and the doctoral bell-shaped sleeves extend to the wrist.

Hoods differ in length and are incrementally longer for each higher degree. The colored edging indicates the academic discipline and the lining signifies the official color or colors of the institution.

The black mortarboard with tassel is worn with each type of gown. Bachelor's and master's degree holders wear a black tassel and those who have earned a doctorate wear a gold tassel. In recent years, there has been a growing tendency to wear a colored tassel symbolizing, like the hood, the subject area in which the wearer has taken a degree.

Today, as in most academic processions, some people wear costumes that do not conform to standard patterns. This is especially true of people who hold degrees from foreign universities where colorful attire often is prescribed.

The Mace

The College Mace serves as a symbol of authority, just as it did in the Middle Ages when a mace bearer accompanied an official taking office or opening court. From the 16th century in England, and since colonial days in the United States, it has become a symbol of office used in ceremonies and is carried by the procession leader or macebearer. The Springfield College Mace was first used at the inauguration of Dr. Randolph W. Bromery, 11th president of Springfield College, on October 30, 1993, and was carried by Professor Frank Wolcott '52, grand marshal. It is traditionally carried at commencement in the spring and the convocation in the fall.

The Grand Marshal

Traditionally, the Grand Marshal carries the Mace, which bears the College seal. It is the responsibility of the Grand Marshal to lead the Academic Procession and serve as the representative of the faculty, which attests that students are, or will be, qualified to receive a Springfield College degree or certificate. Once the President announces that the degree has been conferred, the Grand Marshal raises and lowers the College Mace as a symbol that the Board of Trustees approves the conferral of these degrees.

Commencement Honors and Awards

Students receiving special College-awarded or institutional honors at commencement wear the following honor cords to signify their accomplishments:

Double gold honor cords—Students graduating summa cum laude—Undergraduate students achieving a cumulative grade point average of 3.900 to 4.000

Double maroon honor cords—Students graduating magna cum laude—Undergraduate students achieving a cumulative grade point average of 3.700 to 3.899

Double white honor cords—Students graduating *cum laude*—Undergraduate students achieving a cumulative grade point average of 3.500 to 3.699

Red and green honor cords for biology majors inducted into the Tri Beta Honor Society;

Purple cords issued to seniors inducted into the Kappa Delta Pi Education Honor Society;

Mary-Beth A. Cooper

Springfield College President

Mary-Beth A. Cooper, PhD, DM, became the 13th President of Springfield College in August 2013, bringing to the College her experience from a long and distinguished career in higher education administration and community service.

With her leadership, the Springfield College community has experienced a unified rededication to our Humanics philosophy and mission of leadership in service to others, and has committed itself to educational excellence through cultivation of partnerships that allow students to produce new knowledge and that engage diverse populations. Through collaboration and engagement, she fosters an internal environment that reflects shared governance among faculty, staff, and students, and an external environment that is safe and welcoming for the College community and its city neighbors.

She has created a strategic vision to build an institution that provides a student-centric experience and has overseen the implementation of many initiatives in support of that vision. Most recently, the College launched the \$50 million *Advancing Humanics* comprehensive campaign and began the second phase of



a dynamic strategic planning process. As part of both efforts, she worked with faculty, staff, and students to design the new 76,000 square foot Health Sciences Center that is expected to open in fall 2023. She followed a similar process to create the innovative Harold C. Smith Learning Commons, which brings together faculty excellence, technology, and library services in a full-service learning, research, and project space. Under her leadership, Springfield College and the Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation partnered to create an intercollegiate adaptive baseball field to be enjoyed by athletes of all abilities and contained within our championship-quality intercollegiate baseball field. This field, referred to as the "Springfield Model" by the Ripken Foundation, is the first of its kind and includes an artificial turf field, bullpens, batting cages, a new grandstand, a new scoreboard, and sound system that serves both the adaptive and the Springfield College team fields.

Known for her volunteer leadership, President Cooper serves on the President's Council of the NCAA, chairs the board of directors for Educare Springfield, and is the chair of the NEWMAC Athletic Conference. She is a past chair of the board of directors of the Association of Independent Colleges and Universities in Massachusetts and remains on its board. In addition, she serves on the boards of the Council of Independent Colleges, the Community Foundation of Western Massachusetts, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, the United Way of Pioneer Valley, and the Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation. She previously served on the NCAA Division III Oversight Group to Implement Recommendations of Federal and State Legislation Working Group (also called the Name, Image, and Likeness Committee) and on the National Association of Independent Colleges and Universities Committee on Policy Analysis and Public Relations. She was appointed by Massachusetts Governor Charlie Baker to serve on the Special Commission to Study the Incorporation of Safe and Effective Pain Treatment and Prescribing Practices into the Professional Training of Students that may Prescribe Controlled Substances.

President Cooper earned a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Delaware, a Master of Education from the University of Georgia, a Master of Business Administration from the University of Rochester, a Doctor of Philosophy in education administration from Michigan State University, and a Doctor of Management from Case Western Reserve University.

President Cooper lives on the Springfield College campus with her husband, Dave, and their chocolate lab, Jack. They have a son, Calvin, a 2nd Lieutenant in the U.S. Air Force Services.

Billie Jean King

Legendary Athlete, Equality Champion Commencement Speaker Honorary Degree Recipient

An internationally acclaimed athlete and longtime champion for social change and equality, Billie Jean King has created new inroads for all genders in sports and beyond during her legendary career, and she continues to make her mark today.

Founder of the Billie Jean King Leadership Initiative, she was named one of the 100 Most Important Americans of the 20th Century by *Life* magazine. In recognition of her work as a social justice pioneer and her accomplishments in sports, President Barack Obama awarded her with the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the nation's highest civilian honor.

King grew up playing tennis in the California public parks and went on to win 39 Grand Slam titles during her career. She helped form the Virginia Slims Series and founded the Women's Tennis Association. On Sept. 20, 1973, in one of the greatest moments in sports history, she defeated Bobby Riggs in a tennis match known to the world as the Battle of the Sexes.



In 1974, King co-founded World TeamTennis, the revolutionary professional team tennis league. That same year she also founded the Women's Sports Foundation. In August 2006, the National Tennis Center, home of the US Open, was renamed the USTA Billie Jean King National Tennis Center in honor of her accomplishments on and off the court.

In 2014, King, and her partner Ilana Kloss, launched the Billie Jean King Leadership Initiative to address equality and inclusion issues in the workplace. They were later named to the ownership group of the Los Angeles Dodgers. President Obama named King to the Presidential Delegation to the 2014 Olympic Winter Games in Sochi, Russia.

In 2017, Fox Searchlight released the critically acclaimed film, *Battle of the Sexes*, starring Academy Award® winner Emma Stone as King and Academy Award® nominee Steve Carrell as Bobby Riggs. The film depicts both players' battles on and off the court, as well as the cultural and social impact of the groundbreaking match.

King received a Lifetime Achievement Award in 2018 as part of the prestigious BBC Sports Personality of the Year Awards. ESPN established the Billie Jean King Youth Leadership Award in 2019. The award is presented annually at the network's Sports Humanitarian Awards ceremony.

King's deep southern California roots were recognized in 2019 with the opening of the Billie Jean King Main Library in her hometown of Long Beach, Calif. In 2020, King was honored with the release of the Billie Jean King Barbie doll, part of Mattel's Inspiring Women Series. That same year, she joined the ownership group of Angel City FC, and became the first woman to have an annual global team sports event named in her honor when the Fed Cup, the world cup of women's tennis, was rebranded as the Billie Jean King Cup.

In 2021, she received the Laureus Lifetime Achievement Award and the *Sports Illustrated* Muhammad Ali Legacy Award. Her memoir, *ALL IN: An Autobiography*, was published by Alfred A. Knopf in August 2021.

King serves on the board of the Women's Sports Foundation, and is an adidas Global Ambassador. She is a past member of the board and an Honorary Lifetime President of the Elton John AIDS Foundation, and a past member of the President's Council on Sports, Fitness, and Nutrition.
