- A **minimum cumulative GPA** of 2.000 or higher
- The **residency requirement**—45 credits taken at Springfield College (including 15 of your last 30)

### ENGL Major Requirements – Typical First-Year Schedule

**Fall:**  
SCSM 101, Springfield College Seminar (Core requirement – 3 cr)  
ENGL 113, College Writing I (Core requirement – 3 cr)  
ENGL 160, (3 cr) Introduction to Literary Studies (3 cr – also fills Literature Core)  
  
Plus other Core and major requirements, or electives to total approximately 15 credits

**Spring:**  
ENGL 114, College Writing II (Core requirement – 3 cr)  
  
**One** track course (3 cr) – see track requirements for course options  
  
Plus other Core and major requirements, or electives to total 30 credits for the year

### ENGL Major Requirements – Typical Second-Year Schedule

**Fall or Spring:**  
There are no major requirements specifically recommended for your second year. You should select Core and major requirements, or electives to total 30 credits for the year.

### ENGL Major Requirements – Typical Third-Year Schedule

**Fall or Spring:**  
ENGL 301, Advanced Composition (3 cr)  
  
There are no major requirements specifically recommended for your third year. You should select Core and major requirements, or electives to total 30 credits for the year.

### ENGL Major Requirements – Typical Fourth-Year Schedule

**Fall:**  
Any outstanding Core and major requirements, or electives to total approximately 15 credits

**Spring:**  
ENGL 482, Seminar (3 cr) or  
ENGL 494, Independent Research (1 - 3 cr)  
  
Plus any outstanding major requirements, Core, or electives to total a minimum of 120 credits for your career
