Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund

Report as of 11/13/2020—FINAL REPORT

- Springfield College signed and returned the Recipient's Funding Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on 04/22/2020. Springfield College intends to spend at least 50% of the Higher Education Relief Fund (HEERF) on grants to students.
- Springfield College has or will receive \$1,729,441 under the HEERF student portion.
- As of the reporting date, \$1,729,441 has been distributed to 2,887 students.
- Springfield College estimates 3,458 students are eligible for HEERF.
- Springfield College determined eligibility for ground-based, US citizens or eligible non-citizens, who did not have an unresolved Title IV eligibility flag. Grants were calculated using a formula based on Expected Family Contribution and enrollment status. Grants range from \$200 - \$5,303
- Eligible students are instructed to complete a self-certification, via PrideNET, attesting to their Title IV eligibility and that they have incurred expenses related to the disruption of their education.
- Funds will be distributed directly to students using e-refund and paper check for those without an e-refund account.
