If you are an Accounting major who matriculated to Springfield College in 2017-2018, use this as a guide for sequencing your courses. Requirements listed on this guide are subject to change and may not be offered when listed—use your online degree audit for the most accurate information. ACCT Major – Typical First-Year Schedule	
Fall: BUSM 150, Introduction to Business (3 cr – also fills half of WAC GenEd) ENGL 113, College Writing I (3 cr – fills half College Writing GenEd) Plus GenEds, major requirements with flexible timing, or electives (as applicable) to total approximately 15 credits	Spring: ECON 200, Principles of Macroeconomics (3 cr – also fills Behavioral and Social Sciences GenEd) ENGL 114, College Writing II (3 cr – fills half College Writing GenEd) Plus GenEds, major requirements with flexible timing, or electives (as applicable) to total 30 credits for the year
Fall or Spring: HLTH 100, Wellness: A Way of Life (3 cr – fills Health and Wellness GenEd) CISC 105, Introduction to Computer Concepts or CISC 115, Microcomputer Applications (3 cr – fills Computing/Technology GenEd) MATH 115, College Algebra (3 cr – recommended to fill Quantitative Reasoning GenEd)	

ACCT Major – Typical Second-Year Schedule	
Fall: BUSM 210, Principles of Accounting I (3 cr) Plus GenEds, major requirements with flexible timing, or electives (as applicable) to total approximately 15 credits	Spring: BUSM 211, Principles of Accounting II (3 cr) GenEds, major requirements with flexible timing, or electives (as applicable) to total 30 credits for the year
Fall or Spring: BUSM 215, Principles of Management (3 cr) BUSM 221, Principles of Marketing (3 cr) BUSM 250, Business Communications (3 cr) ECON 205, Principles of Microeconomics (3 cr)	

ACCT Major – Typical Third-Year Schedule	
Fall: BUSM 310, Business Information Systems (3 cr) BUSM 361, Intermediate Accounting I (3 cr) Plus GenEds, major requirements with flexible timing, or electives (as applicable) to total approximately 15 credits	Spring: BUSM 362, Intermediate Accounting II (3 cr) BUSM 430, Business Data Analysis (3 cr) Plus GenEds, major requirements with flexible timing, or electives (as applicable) to total 30 credits for the year
Fall or Spring: BUSM 315, Financial Management (3 cr) BUSM 335, Business Ethics (3 cr – also fills Spiritual/Ethical GenEd)	

ACCT Major – Typical Fourth-Year Schedule

Fall:

GenEds, major requirements with flexible timing, or electives (as applicable) to total approximately 15 credits

Spring:

BUSM 492, Strategic Management (3 cr)
Plus any outstanding major requirements, GenEds, or electives to total a minimum of 120 credits

Fall or Spring:

BUSM 478, Business Law (3 cr)

Additional ACCT Requirements – Flexible Timing

In addition, you must select **three courses** (and 9 cr) from the following:

ACCT 486, Accounting Internship (up to 3 cr)*

BUSM 311, Managerial and Cost Accounting (3 cr)

BUSM 353, Income Taxes (3 cr)

BUSM 450, Auditing (3 cr)

BUSM 460, Advanced Accounting (3 cr)

*SPCO 220, Internship Preparation Seminar (1 cr) is a prerequisite for ACCT 486; it does not count as part of the required 9 cr.

GenEd Requirements, Electives, and College Requirements

This major typically requires 57 credits to complete. In addition to the requirements previously listed, you must complete:

- **Additional GenEds:** 2nd WAC course, Literary Studies, Visual/Performing Arts, Natural Sciences, Historical/Cultural Studies, International/Multicultural Studies, Social Justice, and Physical Activity.
- **23 elective credits or more** (depending on GenEds selected) to total at least 120 credits
- A **minimum cumulative GPA** of 2.000 or higher
- The **residency requirement**—60 credits taken at Springfield College (including 15 of your last 30)
