



## HEERF III Report – Student Portion

For the Period Ending September 30, 2021

- Springfield College signed and returned the Recipient’s Funding Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on 04/22/2020. Springfield College intends to spend at least 50% of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) on grants to students.
- Springfield College has received \$4,464,842 under the HEERF III student portion.
- As of the reporting date, \$3,839,879 has been distributed to 3,164 students. Awards range from \$250 - \$1,825
- Springfield College has determined 4,342 students to be eligible for HEERF III.
- Eligibility for FAFSA filers will be determined based on EFC, academic level, and course load. FAFSA non-filers will be offered an opportunity to complete an online survey of COVID related expenses and losses. Eligibility for respondents will be based on the total expenses and losses.
- FAFSA filers will not need to submit any additional documentation. FAFSA non-filers will need to submit a complete COVID related expenses and losses survey.
- Funds will be distributed directly to students using e-refund and paper check for those without an e-refund account. Students may elect to retain the funds on their tuition account.
