



HEERF II Report – Student Portion

For the Period ending March 31, 2021

- Springfield College signed and returned the Recipient's Funding Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on 04/22/2020. Springfield College intends to spend at least 50% of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) on grants to students.
- Springfield College has received \$1,729,441 under the HEERF II student portion.
- As of the reporting date, \$1,729,441 has been distributed to 3,314 students.
- Springfield College determined 3,399 students are eligible for HEERF II.
- Springfield College determined eligibility US citizens or eligible non-citizens. Grants were calculated using a formula based on Expected Family Contribution and enrollment status. Grants range from \$100 - \$830
- FAFSA non-filers instructed to complete a self-certification, via PrideNET, attesting to their citizenship status.
- Funds were distributed directly to students using e-refund and paper check for those without an e-refund account.
