Always confirm your plans with your minor advisor or the chairperson of the Mathematics/Physics/Computer Science department.

MATH Minor – 18 Credits Required

Students who have a deficiency in their mathematics preparation may be required to take MATH 115, College Algebra, and/or MATH 125, Pre-calculus Mathematics, before taking MATH 140, Calculus I.

MATH 140, Calculus I (3 cr)
MATH 142, Calculus II (3 cr)
MATH 220, Calculus III (3 cr)
MATH 305, Elementary Differential Equations (3 cr)

In addition, you must select 2 courses (6 credits) from the following:

MATH 205, Geometry (3 cr)
MATH 215, Probability and Statistics (3 cr)
MATH 235, Discrete Mathematics I (3 cr)
MATH 310, Linear Algebra (3 cr)
MATH 335, Discrete Mathematics II (3 cr, requires MATH 235 as a prerequisite)
MATH 405, Mathematical Analysis (3 cr)
MATH 415, Abstract Algebra (3 cr)
