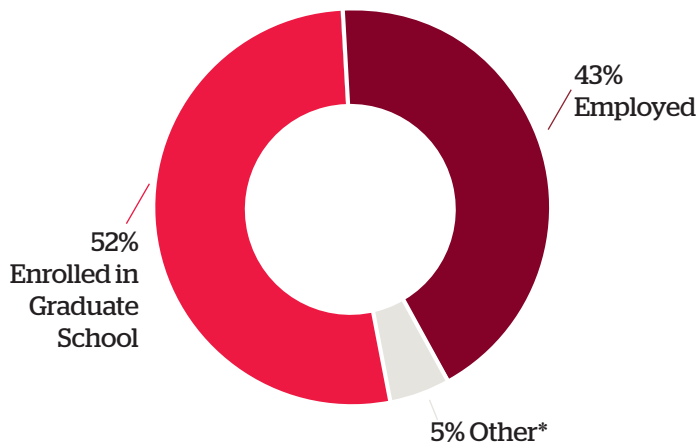

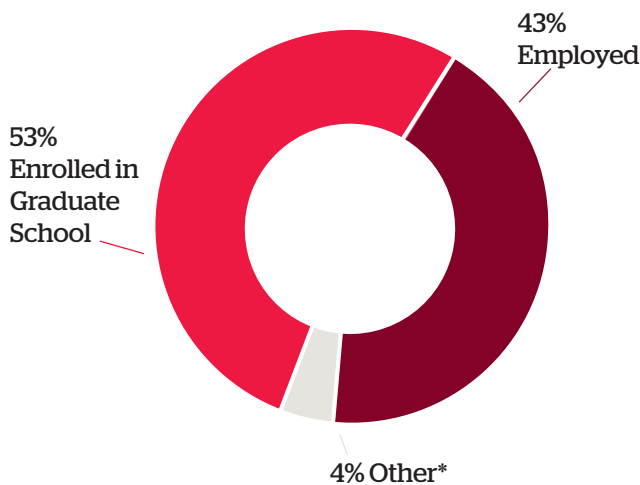


## Successful Career Outcomes Rate

*Note: This report uses data from the 2019-20 post-graduation survey, which is the most current Springfield College data available. The survey was administered in October 2020 to recent alumni who graduated in August 2019, December 2019, or May 2020. Information (the survey and institutional research) was collected from 456 Bachelor degree recipients, with a 85 percent knowledge rate, and to 400 Master/Doctoral degree recipients, with a 90 percent knowledge rate. The data presented include the known status of recent graduates. The knowledge rate for this program is 84 percent.*
