

SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION FOR ADVANCED STANDING

Students who hold a Bachelor of Social Work degree from a Council on Social Work Education-accredited program received within the last five years, and who can demonstrate a mastery of course content and field experience, are eligible to apply for advanced standing. A limited number of students are accepted into this program, which only starts in the summer. Students must complete the entire application to be considered.

To be considered for advanced standing, applicants must provide the following additional materials:

1. All completed or pending field placement supervisory evaluations,
2. A paper representing your best written work from your senior year, and
3. An example of a written assignment from a social work practice course.

An interview may be required for consideration for advanced standing.
