




Successful Career Outcomes Rate

This report uses data from the 2021-22 post-graduation survey, which is the most current Springfield College data available. The survey was administered in October 2022 to recent alumni who graduated in August 2021, December 2021, or May 2022. Information (the survey and institutional research) was collected from 473 bachelor degree recipients, with a 90 percent knowledge rate, and to 371 master/doctoral degree recipients, with a 92 percent knowledge rate. The data presented include the known status of recent graduates. **The knowledge rate for this program is 73 percent**.
