Fall or Spring:

ATPY 309, Pre-Practicum in Art Therapy and Art Education (3 cr)
ATPY 430, Multicultural Issues in Art Therapy (3 cr – also fills the Multicultural component of the International/Multicultural Studies GenEd and the Social Justice GenEd)
Plus GenEds, major requirements with flexible timing, or electives (as applicable) to total 30 credits for the year

ATPY Major – Typical Third-Year Schedule

Fall or Spring:
There are no major requirements specifically recommended for your third year. You should select GenEds, major requirements with flexible timing, or electives (as applicable) to total 30 credits for the year

ATPY Major – Typical Fourth-Year Schedule

ATPY Program Standards

Program standards for the ATPY major include, but are not limited to:

- Have earned a 2.500 GPA or higher in all program requirements
- Have earned a cumulative GPA of 2.500 or higher
- Have earned a C or better in all courses with an ARTS or ATPY prefix

GenEd Requirements, Electives, and College Requirements

This major typically requires 64 to 66 credits to complete. In addition to the requirements previously listed, you must complete:

- **Additional GenEds:** Computing/Technology, Literary Studies, Spiritual/Ethical Dimensions, Quantitative Reasoning, Natural Sciences, Historical/Cultural Studies, Global Studies component of International/Multicultural (or other category ptions), and Physical Activity. You also need to ensure that both WAC requirements are fulfilled.
- **20 to 22 elective credits or more** (depending on GenEds chosen) to total at least 120 credits
- The **residency requirement**—60 credits taken at Springfield College (including 15 of your last 30)
